Footnotes

TAIF was away alertly to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to gain a slight edge with a furlong to run and held late to prevail. ZAGREUS showed no early speed, saved ground through the turn, moved between foes nearing the eighth pole bumping with INHOC SIGNO VINCAS and finished full of run when clear. UGOTTABCATTY raced off the leaders early, lacked racing room in mid-stretch, moved between foes nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with good energy. NOBLE JUAN was off slow, raced off the leaders from the inside, moved up for a contending position with a furlong to run and finished evenly late. OLYMPIC LIGHTS broke in stride to take command at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter and gave way after going five furlongs. EMANCIPATED pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter and gave way. CHICKASAW PARK lacked early foot, angled out nearing the quarter and failed to menace. INHOC SIGNO VINCAS was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn, moved up for a contending position approaching the stretch, was bumped while retreating nearing the sixteenth pole and did not threaten thereafter. The Stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the bumping of ZAGREUS and INHOC SIGNO VINCAS at the sixteenth pole and after reviewing the films made no change.
