BUDDY DAVE lacked early speed, checked nearing the three-eighths pole, moved outside through the turn, responded to steady urging and was up in the final yards. RAINIER set a pressured pace from the outside, opened a clear margin nearing the three-eighths marker and gave way grudgingly to the winner in the drive. ARMED SERVICE was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage RAINIER with a furlong to run but failed to sustain his rally. GETNDOWNTHELANE showed no early speed, checked nearing the three-eighths pole, remained inside into the lane and did not threaten. TOP DUFF raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and failed to rally. RUSH AHEAD was away alertly to press the pace from the inside, was pulled up nearing the three-eighths pole and vanned off.
