Footnotes

WEAVING JUSTICE stalked the clear pace, vied for the lead mid turn, quickly assumed command and drew clear as the rider pleased. SLEWDLEMAGIC was unhurried early, closed the gap through the turn, then swung wide entering the lane and finished well. EMERALD LIGHT stalked inside, split horses on the turn, then angled out entering the stretch to contend but flattened out. CORAL BELLE offered a late rally, closing well through the turn to contend in the upper stretch, but lacked the needed late rally. MISSTERIAN hustled along three deep, then weakened in the upper stretch and dropped back. SAUCER HOOFS rushed to the lead, flashed brief foot, then tired nearing the five-sixteenths pole and faded fast. OMBU dropped far back, and was always outrun. BLACK DIAMOND was fractious in the gate, then gave a dull effort, and was eased home.
