### Footnotes

BLAME THE JOCKEY lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, reached the leaders with a furlong to run and drew clear late. BOGACHIEL broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way grudgingly in the drive. BERRY LEDO was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with good courage. RESCUE PLAN was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, offered a bid nearing the quarter and gave way in the drive. MOBIUS broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gradually gave way. STREET HAVEN was off slow, lagged throughout and did not reach contention.
