Footnotes

YASOU raced off the leaders early, angled outside nearing the quarter, reached CAVEMAN KITCHEN inside the furlong marker and drew clear late. CAVEMAN KITCHEN raced off the leaders from the inside, moved up to take a slight edge with a furlong to run but could not match strides with the winner late. SAHARA SAM raced off the leaders early, steadied in mid-stretch, moved inside late and finished with good energy. BUCKSHOT WEST raced off the leaders early, raced wide through the second turn, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter and failed to gain in the drive. LUX LUTHER went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter and gave way after going six furlongs. SOUP KITCHEN was bumped hard at the break, raced far wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. GRANDEST SLAM broke in the air and was bumped, pressed the pace from between foes and gave way after going six furlongs. DR. DANIEL broke in the air and was bumped, raced far back early, moved outside through the second turn and did not menace. LARRYTHESTABLEGUY chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. BOLD OFFICER chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after a half.
