HI AND GOODBYE dueled for the lead from the inside with WHO'S YOUR NEXT EX, disposed of that rival into the lane, opened a clear lead and off the closing SNOW ON THE RIVER. SNOW ON THE RIVER showed no early speed, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole and was gaining on the winner late. WHO'S YOUR NEXT EX broke sharply to duel for the lead with the winner, dropped off that rival into the stretch and finished with good courage while being lightly hand urged in the drive. MEDICINE CREEK was bumped at the start, raced just off the pacesetters from the inside, moved up for a contending position in mid-stretch but failed to gain late. CHET THE JET was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from between rivals, moved outside through the second turn and lacked the needed rally. JOE BLACK SANDY chased the leaders from the outside, lugged out through both turns and was eased through the lane.
