BLUESWATER stalked the leaders from the outside throughout, responded when set down for the drive and caught FLYING WITH FAITH in the final yards. FLYING WITH FAITH went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace, increased her margin into the stretch but could not hold off the winner late. R W DUSTY'S GIRL raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and finished with a solid late rally. OUR LIL' ELFIE showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with some late run. SURELYBELL lacked early speed, raced wide into the lane and failed to menace. WHY TOMORROW chased the leaders from the outside and gave way after going six furlongs. GUESSAWAY was void of early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and did not threaten. JASWINDER raced off the leaders early, saved ground into the lane and did not offer a bid.
