FIVE STAR PROMISE broke in, stalked the leaders from between foes, moved up to take a slight edge into the lane and held game to the wire. HIJO DEL SOL raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn, came back inside into the lane and finished with good energy. PRINCE GIDDYUP showed no early speed, angled out nearing the five-sixteenths pole and finished with good late speed. RINGO'S GOLD was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside, offered a bid nearing the three-sixteenths pole and gave way in the drive. NEWAUKUM CREEK was off slow, saved ground throughout and finished with some late run. OWEN ALMIGHTY chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after the opening quarter. BUD E TEE broke out, opened a clear lead before going a quarter and weakened after going a half. WEST COAST TOPPER was off slow, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
