Footnotes

AKINA raced off the leader early, angled outside into the lane, reached SKIMMING THE WAVE inside the furlong marker and edged away late. SKIMMING THE WAVE was away alertly to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the quarter, opened a clear lead but could not match strides with the winner in the drive. APPEALING RESUME chased the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the five-sixteenths pole and finished with good energy. AQUATIC CAT lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole and finished with a solid late bid. PATIENCE REWARDED was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out in mid-stretch and finished evenly. PISTOLPACKIN'GAL was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. SHAME ON ROSIE went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter and weakened after going a half.
