STORM IN SESSION stalked the pace racing four wide, assumed command leaving the second turn, opened clear and was ridden out to maintain a safe advantage. PAPAS PISTOL was unhurried early, swung four wide to make his bid, loomed large entering the stretch, was unable to reach the winner, then was all out to just hold the place. CLEAR FOR ACTION settled saving ground, waited in traffic leaving the second turn, angled out entering the stretch, and finished willingly once clear. BIG BAD BUE disputed the pace racing three wide, but weakened entering the stretch and gave way. MILITARY DEPUTY was allowed to settle into stride, came three wide to make a mild bid from between horses, but failed to sustain the drive. ADOBE HILL pulled to contention from between horses, but came up empty after a half and dropped out. KEYS A DON JUAN dueled for the lead racing along the inside, stopped leaving the second turn, was pulled up in mid stretch but walked off.
