SEVENTEENMILEDRIIVE raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch, responded to steady urging and wore down the leaders through the final yards. GOLDLEDUE broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside, dropped off OUR MARSHAL CAHILL nearing the five-sixteenths pole, also responded when set down for the drive and finished with good courage. HOLLOW THE GOLD was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out at the quarter and eighth pole and finished with good energy. OUR MARSHAL CAHILL dueled for the early advantage from the inside, opened a clear margin nearing the five-sixteenths pole and gave way through the final sixteenth. KASINO MAN was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. CAMP PENDLETON was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. ZILVER raced off the pacesetters throughout and gradually weakened. RED BALL EXPRESS was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor.
