ARMED SERVICE was away alertly to stalk the leaders from the outside, angled out further nearing the quarter and again outside nearing the eighth pole and wore down RINGO'S GOLD through the final yards. RINGO'S GOLD raced wide through both turns, raced just off the leaders, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the quarter, opened a clear margin with a furlong to run but could not resist the winner late. GIVAJUNIOR MINT stalked the leaders from the inside, steadied nearing the three-quarter pole, stayed on and finished willingly in the drive. STORY BEHIND IT sprinted clear soon after the start, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way in the drive. REGAL FEVER lacked early foot, raced wide through the second turn and did not threaten. J. T. ROCKS showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention.
