CAMP GRANADA sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, increased his margin into the lane and was ridden out to the wire to be kept to task. JOHNSKI steadied nearing the five-eighths marker, raced off the leaders from the outside, could not gain on his stable-mate in the drive but was up late for the place. ANKENY HILL came in to impede rivals nearing the five-eighths pole, chased the winner from the outside, was no match for that foe in the drive and lost the runner-up award in the final yards. CITY TWISTER showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. BOUND TO WIN chased the leaders from the inside, steadied sharply nearing the five-eighths pole and dropped far back thereafter. The stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the steadying of both BOUND TO WIN and JOHNSKI at the five-eighths pole and after reviewing the films concluded ANKENY HILL had drifted inward to impede both horses and was disqualified from third and placed fifth.
