BRITE OAKIE rushed up to duel for the lead from along the inside, battled gamely through a prolonged drive, and inched away in the final yards. PETER'S CHARITY stalked the pace racing along the inside, angled out entering the stretch to make his bid, finished willingly and was getting to the winner late. TWO INTENT dueled for the lead racing two wide, but weakened slightly during the drive and grudgingly gave way. FREE ON BAIL was allowed to settle into stride, came five wide to make a mild rally, but failed to seriously threaten. PRAYINFORABOGEY dropped far back, came three wide to make a belated gain from between horses, but was never a factor. CHARMING SEATTLE was away alertly, dropped back early and went evenly thereafter. ONEMOREPULL chased the pace racing three wide, but weakened leaving the the turn and faded. BUCKSHOT WEST pulled to contention racing four wide, but came up empty after a half and dropped out.
