Footnotes

D'HONORABLE ONE stalked the pace of MAKORS FINALE from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the quarter, gained a slight edge in mid-stretch and gamely held for the dead-heat. MAKORS FINALE sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, responded when challenged by D'HONORABLE ONE approaching the stretch, vied with that rival through a prolonged drive and came back gamely to finish on even-terms. BRADY'S KAT showed no early speed, saved ground into the stretch, angled out nearing the eighth pole and finished with good energy. CITY TWISTER was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. BRUDDA CLYDE raced off the pacesetters early, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the quarter and failed to sustain his rally in the drive. HAVANNA RED chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going five furlongs. JOHNSKI lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. FIRST LAST CHANCE was void of early foot, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor.
