PRINCE GIDDYUP was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, responded to steady urging and wore down GOLD HARBOR in the closing yards. GOLD HARBOR sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, held sway into mid-stretch but could not hold the winner safe late. CASTLE ROMEO showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and finished with a late rally. IT'S OUR PLEASURE lunged at the break, raced wide through the turn and finished with a belated bid. STORMIN' PATRICK raced just off the leaders from the outside, angled out approaching the stretch and gave way in the drive. GIVAJUNIOR MINT was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the inside and gradually gave way. BOISE CREEK broke in, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. PRIVATE SWING was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half.
