RIGHT YOU ARE settled racing in hand, launched a bold bid racing five wide leaving the turn, and quickly drew away to score as the rider pleased. SUGAR SLEET pressed the pace racing four wide, was unable to match strides with the winner entering the stretch, but continued on willingly to hold the place. PERSONAL PLAN stalked the pace racing along the inside, angled out to make a mild rally entering the stretch, and was along in time to earn the show. SWEET ROAD dueled for the lead racing along the inside, but flattened out during the drive and gave way. IRISH TRIBUTE dueled for the lead racing three wide from between horses, but faltered leaving the turn and faded. WHAT ABOUT QUIN showed brief speed racing along the inside, but was through after a half and dropped out.
