SEVENTY SIXER was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the outside, relinquished the lead to NAVAJO GOLD with a furlong to run and came back to prove best over that rival in a prolonged drive. NAVAJO GOLD broke sharply to press the pace from the inside, moved up to take command with a sixteenth to run but could not hold the winner safe late. MILITARY DEPUTY raced off the pacesetters from the inside and finished evenly in the drive. ROCK THE STONE lacked early speed, saved ground into the stretch, angled out with a furlong to run and finished with some late run. BIG HERO chased the leaders from the outside and gave way gradually. SEVEN EAGLES was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not menace. PENN COVE was never far back while racing from the outside and gave way after six furlongs. WALLY BALLOU trailed the field throughout.
