**Footnotes**

KICKAPOLE was away alertly to stalk the leaders from off the rail, moved up to take command with three-sixteenths to run and held sway to the wire. MOB RULE showed no early speed, began working his way forward from the outside, angled further out into the lane and finished with good energy. DANCES WITH EAGLES raced off the leaders from the outside and finished willingly in the drive. HE'S COOL was off a step slow, saved ground into the stretch and finished with some late run. RIVERSIDE GAMBLER went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter and gave way after six furlongs. SHIMMY CAT was never far back while racing along the inside and lacked the needed closing response. PETE'S BOY lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not menace. LAZARO raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor. HE'S A BARN RAT showed no early foot, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. PARISIAN SLEW raced off the leaders from the inside and weakened after a half.
