SEND SILVER pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the five-sixteenths pole and drew off through the lane. MADOFF WITH IT ALL showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled further out approaching the stretch and finished with good energy. EL GRAN BEBE was never far back, raced wide through the turn and failed to gain in the drive. BIG BAD BROWN lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with some late run. CAMP GRANADA raced just off the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, steadied nearing the eighth pole. raced in tight quarters and was not urged thereafter. GOLD CHIP broke sharply to set a pressured pace for a half and weakened. DOUBLE BLUFF raced off the leaders from between foes and weakened in the drive. WINORBEGONE was never far back while racing along the inside and gradually weakened. GENUINE GEM showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
