AUNT SOPHIE was unhurried early, swung five wide leaving the turn to launch her bid, finished full of run, and was just up in the final stride. MARVA JEAN settled racing in hand while three wide, angled out to make her move entering the stretch, forged command and continued on willingly but was turned away in the last jump. LASTING CODE stalked the pace racing along the inside, angled out entering the stretch, offered her bid racing three wide, but failed to sustain the drive. PRINCESS FOREVER rushed up to duel for the lead with CASCADE CORONA racing two wide, had her rein break nearing the three-eighths pole, bumped that rivals sharply, was quickly straighten but weakened from between horses in the drive. CASCADE CORONA dueled from the inside for the lead, was bumped hard and hit the rail near the three-eighths pole losing action, got through and came again but lacked the needed late response. NEON QUEEN settled in the second flight and failed to respond. PIC EM HOF chased the pace racing three wide for a half and dropped out. Following a Stewards inquiry PRINCESS FOREVER was disqualified from fourth and placed fifth for bumping CASCADE CORONA forcing that one to hit the rail.
