BILLY BOY BLUE went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, increased his margin through the back-stretch and held sway to the wire. DR. J. C. lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn, could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished well to save the place. KING NAZARIO showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with good energy. REASON TO RECKON was away alertly to chase the leaders from off the rail and gave way in the drive. FORT MADISON was never far back while racing along inside and finished evenly. OCEANBEACH raced off the leaders early, angled out into the lane and lacked the needed closing response. ANAWKSUNAMIN raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and did not threaten. TEMPLETON raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and did not menace.
