FREE BEER lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn, responded to steady urging and wore down the leaders through the final yards to be going away late. SHAMUNDI raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn, reached the fore with a sixteenth to run but could not match strides with the winner late. RICKY RICKY raced off the leaders early, angled out approaching the stretch, moved up to contend nearing the eighth pole but could not stay with the closers late. EMANCIPATED dueled for the lead from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. ADVANCEMENT dueled for the early advantage from off the rail and also gave way through the final eighth. WIN PHOTOS WILL DO was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and failed to rally. TOUCH THE SUN was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half.
