Footnotes

ONCE UPON A SONG sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace and held sway to the wire. EVER READY CARRIE was bumped at the start, chased her stable-mate from the outside throughout and failed to gain on that foe in the drive. LADY VIVIEN was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, began to work her way forward from the inside through the turn, angled out nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with good energy. SWISS CHARM was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out approaching the stretch but failed to gain on the leaders late. SHE'S MY FAVORITE showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten. MAUI ROSE broke sharply to chase the leaders from off the rail and weakened after going a half. BOBBYLOUIE lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention. SEMELE raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and gradually weakened.
