COUNTRY SQUARE was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, moved up to engage leaders with a furlong to run and gamely held to the wire. NEW YORK BABY was away alertly to duel for the lead from between foes and gave way grudgingly to the winner through a prolonged drive. ROVASCO showed no early speed while racing along the inside, angled out nearing the five-sixteenths pole, reached the leaders nearing the furlong marker but failed to gain on the top pair late. RINGO'S GOLD was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the inside and gave way after going a half. KACTUS RELEVATION showed brief speed and weakened. GOOD AS IT GETS was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from between foes and weakened after going three furlongs.
