**Footnotes**

NICK'S GOLD was away alertly to open a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace, maintained a safe margin into the lane and held on to a diminishing margin to prevail. BORN'N BLUE GENES showed no early speed, saved ground into the stretch, raced in tight quarters late, found room and just missed. AFLEET BUD broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside throughout and finished with good courage in the drive. UM UM GOOD STUFF was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, steadied nearing the five-sixteenths pole, angled out into the lane and finished with good energy. CANVASBACK COVE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not threaten. GOLDEN BOY MARK raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter and failed to menace. REEL POPULAR raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and was not a factor. DEPUTY MACKENZIE chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going three-quarters. OLIVERQUIGLEY chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after a half.
