HAVIN A GOOD DAY was allowed to settle into stride, circled the field on the turn, rallied along the outside and drew clear late. AUBURN XPRESS bumped at the start, set the pace along the rail and finished gamely. PRESS RELEASE was unhurried early, raced between foes on the turn, angled out in mid stretch and finished willingly. CANDYMAN SLEW pressed the pace along the inside and weakened in the late stages. PEPITO AT LAST bumped at the start, pressed the pace while racing two wide and also weakened. BROKER RON was never a factor. HECK YA steadied at the half mile pole, swung six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. OUTOFTHE SALE was bumped at the start, pressed the pace, raced three wide into the lane and tired.
