R SAMURAI was away alertly to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the three-sixteenths pole, opened a clear lead and was fully extended to hold off the closing PHANTOM WARRIOR. PHANTOM WARRIOR was never far back, raced wide through the second turn, responded to steady encouragement and was gaining on the winner late. SOUP KITCHEN raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn and finished with good energy. PONCHO lagged early, angled out nearing the quarter and passed tiring foes late. GOTADOWATSISIDTOO raced off the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened. REASON TO RECKON went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and weakened after going three-quarters. LACUENTA POR FAVOR lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and failed to menace.
