Footnotes

JUST JOKIN AROUND was never far back while racing along the inside, moved up to engage OUR SOULJA BOY with a furlong to run and edged away from that rival through the final yards. OUR SOULJA BOY was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, moved up to offer a bid from the far outside nearing the quarter, gained a slight edge in mid-stretch but could not resist the winner late. GAME EMPEROR raced off the pacesetters early, angled extremely wide approaching the stretch and finished with good energy. DECAR RUN was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. WARREN'S A LEGEND was away alertly the dropped off the leaders, saved ground through the turns and failed to menace. J. T. ROCKS broke sharply to chase the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened. CHARLES ANDREWS was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten. JESUP dueled for the lead from the outside and gave way after going six furlongs. NACHES MATT was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the inside and also weakened after three-quarters.
