DIAMOND INDY raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, responded to steady handling and wore down WIN TO WIN in the closing yards. WIN TO WIN was bumped at the start, duelled for the lead from the inside, opened a clear lead nearing the half and gave way to the winner late. WEST SEATTLE BOY was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished willingly. CLURMOR raced off the leaders from off the rail, steadied nearing the seven-sixteenths marker, moved inside into the lane and finished evenly in the drive. STORM IN SESSION hesitated at the break, raced far wide through the second turn and found his best stride late. MAGOO CAN DO was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention. DO I chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after three-quarters. BERNIE WHITE SHOES was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and stopped after going a half.
