Footnotes

ROBBOS COURAGE sprinted clear early, shook loose on the second turn, met the challenge from EMANCIPATED near the sixteenth pole and edged away from that one late. EMANCIPATED was in the second flight early from the inside, ranged up to offer a bid near the sixteenth pole but was not good enough and had to settle for the runner up spot. FOLLOWS NONE raced along in the second flight early, finished evenly to complete the top flight. COASTAL KING allowed to settle into stride early, came five wide into the stretch but lacked the needed late response. SHARPER EAGLE settled into stride, failed to menace. PLATINUM KATILLAC slow early on, was six wide at the quarter pole and failed to threaten. PIRATES DEPUTY middle of the pack early, was outrun and tired late. CHICKASAW PARK was five wide on the first turn, chased the winner through the second turn and faded.
