MY FRIEND LUIS raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out into the lane, gained command in mid-stretch and quickly drew off. MISTER GIGGLES was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way in the final furlong. SEVEN EAGLES lacked early speed, saved ground into the stretch and found his best stride late. CHICK MAGNET was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way after five furlongs. CRAFTY WAGNER broke in the air, saved ground early and finished evenly through the lane. HE'S A BARN RAT was void of early speed, angled out into the lane and failed to rally. WEAVE BIN SLEWED pressed the pace from the outside for the opening quarter and gradually gave way. CLARA'S CHOICE was void of early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not menace. WANT TO TRAVEL was away alertly to duel for the lead from between foes and weakened after the opening quarter.
