Footnotes

BAD BOY K was away in good order to set a pressured pace from the inside, turned back the bid of SNOOPER DAUPER nearing the three-sixteenths pole and held that rival safe through the final yards. SNOOPER DAUPER broke sharply to press the pace of the winner from the outside, moved up to offer a bid into the lane but could not get by that rival in the drive. MANSION MAYHEM was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the inside, lacked racing room into the lane and failed to respond when clear late. GILMORE was never far back, raced wide through the turn and lacked the needed closing response. SMOKENOMORE showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and failed to threaten. MO'EM DOWN was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention. EAGLE BUTTE raced off the pacesetters and gradually weakened.
