KENZIE CAROLINA was away in good order to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear margin nearing the half and drew off through the lane with little need of urging. ZIPPIN E pressed the pace of the winner from the outside, was no match for that rival but held on well to save the place. GET WELL was never far back while racing from off the rail and failed to gain in the drive. SCENT OF CHRISM raced off the pacesetters from the inside throughout and finished evenly in the drive. SMOKIN BADGE was void of early foot, raced far wide through the second turn and lacked the needed rally. PICKLED AGAIN showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. MATTY'S SWEETHEART chased the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened.
