LOUIE FERGASON dueled for the lead racing three wide, opened clear leaving the turn, and was ridden out to score as the rider pleased. MARINE MIKE prompted the pace racing between horses, battled determinedly through a prolonged drive, and was all out to just hold the place. COPS TRUE GRIT made a steady advance circling four wide and was along in time to earn the show. HE'S A BARN RAT dueled for the lead racing along the inside, but weakened during the drive and gave way. CRAZY RALPH was bumped early and bobbled, settled saving ground, got through to make a mild bid, but failed to sustain the drive. OUR SINGING BOY was slow into stride fall far back, made a belated gain, but was never a factor. BELLS A BOPPIN showed little.
