MEL AND AL sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, responded when challenged in mid-stretch, drifted out and bumped repeatedly with JUSTANOTHER BOB and held narrowly over that rival. JUSTANOTHER BOB was bumped at the start, tracked MEL AND AL from the inside, angled out nearing the eighth pole, bumped with DISCO D soon after, bumped with the winner repeatedly late and finished with good courage. DISCO D chased MEL AND AL from the outside throughout, bumped with that rival in mid-stretch and finished willingly through a prolonged drive. AWESOME TOCCET raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and finished with a late bid. THIS LAD IS GOLD raced wide through the turns, raced just off the leaders throughout and steadied in the final yards. J. T. ROCKS was bumped at the start, steadied nearing the three-quarter marker, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. HOOKED ON GOLD was forwardly placed for a half and weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the bumping between MEL AND AL and JUSTANOTHER BOB through the final sixteenth and after reviewing the films disqualified MEL AND AL and placed him second for causing the infraction.
