Footnotes

HARD SLIDER sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and drew off through the lane to win with complete authority. A K RACER broke sharply to chase the winner from the outside throughout, could not gain on that rival in the drive but finished well to save the place. SILVER SNEAKERS was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. OLYMPIC LIGHTS was bumped at the start, raced wide through the turn, moved between rivals nearing the three-sixteenths pole and finished with some late run. TAPADERO broke in, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. ONE LUCKY HOSS was pinched back at the start, saved ground through the turn, angled out approaching the stretch and failed to menace. OUTA CROWN chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going a half. GOLD HARBOR was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the far outside and gradually weakened. PRINCE GIDDYUP was fractious at the gate and lagged throughout.
