ITALIAN BOY was away alertly to stalk the pace of WAR WIZARD from the inside, angled out nearing the five-sixteenths pole, moved up into the lane to take command and quickly drew off. WAR WIZARD broke sharply to open a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace, yielded to the winner in the drive but held on well to save the place. HARBOR WIND was never far back, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with a good late bid. TOUGH ROAD AHEAD raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and finished with some late run. RED COLT FORTYFIVE lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. POWER FLEET showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention.
