KENDINI was away alertly to set a pressured pace from off the rail and held gamely to the wire. DOC DUFFY broke in, raced just off the leaders, steadied nearing the quarter, lacked racing room in mid-stretch, angled out and finished with good energy. OUR REVOLUTION broke sharply to press the pace of the winner from the outside and lacked the needed closing response. MAJOR INCIDENT pressed the pace from the outside and gave way after going three furlongs. OLDTIMERS VISION was off a step slow, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention. COACH VINCE showed brief speed and stopped.
