HAVE'N A WILD TIME was never far back while racing from off the rail, responded to steady urging and wore down JACOBITA through the final yards. JACOBITA chased the leaders from the outside, moved up to gain command nearing the quarter, opened a clear lead, drifted out and could not resist the winner late. DUCOTI hopped at the start, moved up quickly to open a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way after going six furlongs. CAT VON DIVA chased the leaders from the outside for three-quarters and weakened. FIESTY LASS lagged throughout.
