Footnotes

JEBRICA raced off the pacesetters early, angled out approaching the stretch, wore down WINNING MACHINE through the final sixteenth and held off the closing STRYKER PHD to prevail. STRYKER PHD hopped at the start, showed no early speed, raced far wide through the second turn, moved inside nearing the eighth pole, angled back out through the closing yards and finished full of run. WINNING MACHINE was bumped at the start, pressed the pace of MAKORS FINALE from the outside, moved up to take command with a furlong to run, responded when challenged by the winner soon after and gave way grudgingly late. WHY NOT BE PERFECT raced just off the pacesetters throughout while going wide through both turns and lacked the needed late response. MAKORS FINALE set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. HOIST chased the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. ASSESSMENT was off slow, moved up to race off the pacesetters from the inside and gradually weakened. ROCKY'S QUEST raced off the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. KOOKY SALUKI was void of early foot, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor.
