YAKUTAT was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when challenged in mid-stretch by DECLAN DOWNS and held that rival off safely to the wire. DECLAN DOWNS broke sharply to press the pace from the outside, moved up to engage the winner with a furlong to run but could not get by that rival in the drive. PASSION LIVES HERE lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy. COUNTRY SQUARE was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the inside, angled out late and finished with some late run. MUFAAJY lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with a belated bid. D DEVIL was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. OH SO MACHO was void of early foot, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. GOLDEN N SWEET lagged throughout.
