Footnotes

GUZZLINGIN was allowed to settle early, moved far outside through the tun, reached MORE THAN FRIENDS inside the sixteenth marker and edged that foe late. MORE THAN FRIENDS hopped at the start, raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, gained a slight edge inside the sixteenth pole and just missed. CURVITUDE was off a step slow, lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the stretch, steadied and angled out nearing the sixteenth marker and finished with good energy. CATY WAMPUS chased the leaders from the inside, angled out in mid-stretch and lacked the needed closing response. BRING CHANCES HEAT stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the quarter, opened a clear margin in mid-stretch, went wrong, was eased late and vanned off. WINORBEGONE sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way after going a half. MARQUETCHING broke out, raced just off the leaders, moved outside through the turn and weakened after a half. BROTHER DAVE was off slow and lagged throughout.
