WALLY BALLOU lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with some late run. MONEY UP FRONT was off a step slow, raced off the rail throughout and finished evenly late. MILITARY DEPUTY raced off the leaders from between foes and lacked the needed closing response. BIG HERO lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor. HAPPY ONE was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way after six furlongs. JUEZ TIMELESS (ARG) was never far back while racing along the inside and weakened after going a half.
