GENTLEMAN LAWYER was off a step slow, began to advance from the inside, through the turn, reached ROYAL GAME nearing the three-sixteenths marker and steadily drew off. ROYAL GAME went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail into the lane and gave way to the winner in the drive. ENUMERATOR broke sharply to chase the leaders from between foes and finished evenly. THIRTEENGOLDHEARTS showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not threaten. SEATTLE SHOOFLY was never far back while racing from the outside and gradually weakened.
