GESCHE'S JOY raced off the leaders early, moved between foes nearing the quarter, responded to steady urging and wore down ORANGE SHERBET in the final yards. ORANGE SHERBET broke sharply to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up take command nearing the five-sixteenths pole, opened a clear margin in mid-stretch but could not hold the winner safe late. SASHA B sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, angled out nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with good courage. WAVE HER ON was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the inside and lacked the needed late response. PLATINUM STILETTO raced wide through both turns and finished evenly in the drive. LIBBY CREEK lacked early foot, raced between foes into the lane and did not reach contention. BUTTON EM UP was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going five furlongs.
