ROSES TONITE set the pressured pace, gamely edged clear under heavy urging. PENNTANA settled in mid pack, roused nearing the three-eighths pole, circled four wide on the turn and was gaining fast. A. J.'S LIL SIS pressed the pace from the outside, battled gamely to mid stretch, then gave way. GIRLS NITE was never far back, closed the gap driving between horses, but lacked the late response. MIGHBABA rallied through the turn, swung wide entering the stretch and made a mild gain. TRUMPING failed to respond. PEPPERMINT TWIST lunged at the start and fell far back, passed only tiring rivals. SKY VALLEY KNIGHT steadily retreated. NOTO PONUS hustled along inside, was used up and stopped.
