TAKE ISSUE hustled along early to get the lead, set the pace, kicked clear on the turn and was fully extended to hold off REASON TO BUCK under steady urging. The latter chased the winner early, made a late rally inside the furlong marker and just missed. GREEK BALLETT allowed to settle early, saved ground on the turn, angled out in the upper stretch to launch her rally but had too much to do. BORGIA BASKET tracked the early leaders from three wide and finished evenly. WHISTLE TESTER stalked the early pace from the inside and weakened.
