TOM BOMBADIL raced off the leaders early, angled out nearing the quarter, reached the leaders nearing the sixteenth pole and drew clear late. DO BOY was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside, gained a slight edge inside the furlong marker but could not match strides with the winner late. CHEROKEE COLE lagged early, moved far outside through the turn and finished full of run. THATS GOOD STUFF was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. IRISH HARMONY lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. ONLY BE CAUSE was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. PRIMO GIFT broke awkwardly, chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after five furlongs. COUGAR DEFENSE lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not menace.
