NOOSA BEACH broke in stride to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear lead into the lane and drew off through the lane while being ridden out to be kept to task. GALLON showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn, was no match for the winner in the drive but finished with good energy to be clearly second best. ROOSTER CITY was never far back while being stoutly rated, raced off the rail into the lane and finished willingly. WASSERMAN was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground through the second turn, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with some late run. ELUSIVE SCHEMES was away alertly to press the pace from the outside and gave way after going six furlongs. ASSESSMENT was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and lacked the needed closing response. YANKEE BRAVO was off slow, moved up from the inside to offer a bid nearing the five-eighths pole and weakened after going three-quarters. WINNING MACHINE raced off the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened.
